Pope Francis often speaks of the church as a field hospital.

It is a very helpful image to think of our church as such. Pope Francis is thinking of the hospitals that are set up in the vicinity of a war zone where the wounded come to have their wounds tended to. It is a portrayal of the church that reflects the ministry of Jesus.

Jesus tended to the wounded, in body, mind and spirit. Our Gospel reading today highlights that dimension of Jesus' ministry: 'cure all kinds of diseases and sickness...cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out devils'. Jesus proclaims the presence of the kingdom of God by attending to other people's needs. He has compassion on the crowds who come to him and seem harassed and dejected like sheep without a shepherd. A response was needed. So Jesus sends out the twelve as labourers to a harvest, with authority to proclaim the closeness of God's kingdom by curing all kinds of diseases and sicknesses. Hereby Jesus proclaims the ministry of his disciples, the ministry of the church, is to be a continuation of Jesus' own healing ministry. Christian Art, London
