It gives us the Good News that no tomb can hold us down anymore - not the tomb of despair, discouragement, doubt or death itself. Instead, we are expected to live a joyful and peaceful life, constantly experiencing the real presence of the Risen Lord in all the events of our lives. "This is the day the Lord has made: let us rejoice and be glad" (Psalm 118:24).

"In the light of the Risen Lord, our sufferings are now transfigured. Where there was death, now there is life. Where there was mourning, now there is consolation. In embracing the cross, Jesus bestowed meaning on our sufferings and now we pray that the benefits of that healing will spread throughout the world. 
"Are you the King of the Jews?" Pilate asked.




Jesus replied "Do you ask this of your own accord, or have others spoken to you about me?"



Pilate answered, "Am I a Jew? It is your own people and the chief priests who have handed you over to me what have you done?"








