my problems.

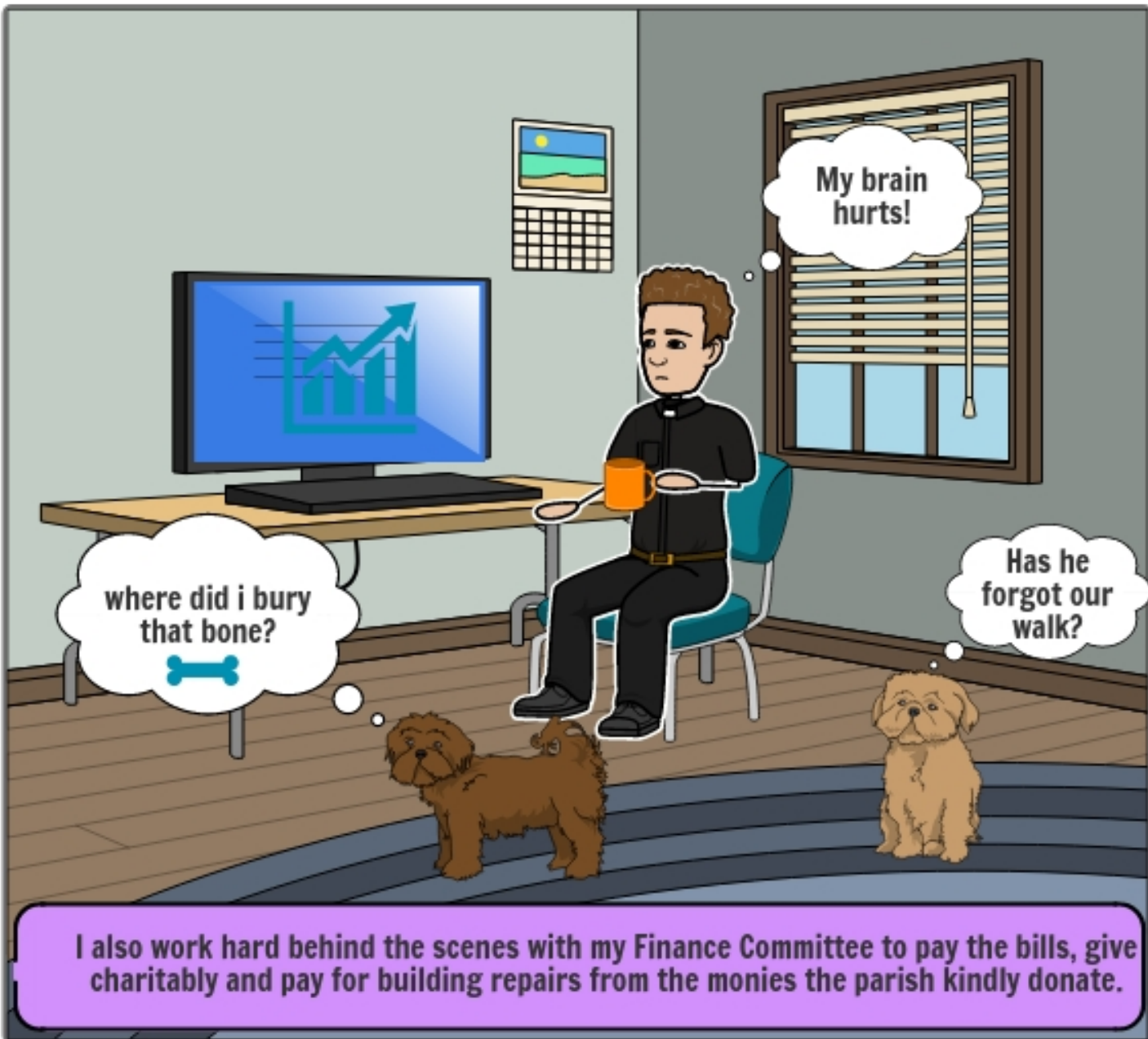


Marriage Preparation


