


Believing in Risen Life - After his death and burial, the apostles saw the risen Jesus. They talked with him. They touched him. They ate with him. These things are not done with the dead. They knew he was alive. We believe this still today because we experience his presence in many ways. Didn't Jesus tell us not to worry and to not be afraid? Either we believe in the message of Easter, or we don't! The resurrection of Christ is really all about receiving the gifts of trust and faith and doing new things. Find a way to trust that this is true and live. How do I see the risen Lord's activity still happening today? How can I foster belief in the risen Lord by what I say and do? How does this belief change my life, my attitudes, my priorities?

Having <u>encountered</u> the Risen Lord, like the disciples, we cannot keep the joy of the Good News, the New Life in Christ to ourselves. We must go out to proclaim that Jesus is the One who gives us life.
